

INDIAN LAKE BOROUGH

ORDINANCE NO. 176

An Ordinance allowing operation of registered Neighborhood Electric Vehicles on roadways with posted speed limit of 35 MPH or less within and under the jurisdiction of Indian Lake Borough, Somerset County, PA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Indian Lake Borough, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, that:

Whereas, The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has revised the Vehicle Code [Title 75 - Vehicles] to add Subchapter F, OPERATION OF NEIGHBORHOOD ELECTRIC VEHICLES [NEVs], to Chapter 35, SPECIAL VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS, hereinafter referred to simply as "Subchapter F", and

Whereas, Subchapter F allows NEVs to be operated on local roads with posted speed limits of 25 MPH or less, and

Whereas, Subchapter F allows local authorities to, by ordinance or resolution, for any roadway under their jurisdiction, permit the use of NEVs where the posted speed limit is greater than 25 miles per hour but not greater than 35 miles per hour.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:


1. The Council of Indian Lake Borough hereby declares that NEVs be allowed to operate on local roads within and under the jurisdiction of Indian Lake Borough having a posted speed limit of not greater than 35 MPH.
2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon thirty (30) days after the date of the adoption.
3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
