

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING ON BOROUGH  
STREETS OF INDIAN LAKE BOROUGH, SOMERSET  
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES  
FOR VIOLATION OF PARKING REGULATIONS

The Borough of Indian Lake hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: The boundary limits of the Borough of Indian Lake are hereby established as a zone in which motor vehicles may remain standing, without lights, and all Borough streets and alleys within such boundary limits are hereby designated as streets where motor vehicles may remain standing, without lights, subject to the further provisions of this Ordinance as hereinafter set forth and subject to the provisions of the Motor Vehicle Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2: Parking is prohibited within the travelled portion of all Borough streets, the minimum limits of which travelled portion of said Borough streets shall be not less than ten (10) feet on either side of the center line of said Borough streets.

SECTION 3: Any person who shall violate the provisions of Section 2 of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Two Dollars (\$2.00) nor more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than five (5) days.

SECTION 4: All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
