**RESOLUTION FOR PLAN ADOPTION
RESOLUTION OF THE
BOROUGH COUNCIL OF
INDIAN LAKE BOROUGH, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
(hereinafter "the municipality")**

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1996, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the **Pennsylvania Code**, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, Indian Lake Borough has prepared an Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan which provides for sewage facilities in Indian Lake Borough, and

The alternative of choice to be implemented is referred to as Alternative Number 5, which is a grinder pump/pressure sewage system that will provide service to the existing residents and vacant lots. Sewage service along the North Shore will be provided by the pressure sewer system, while a sewage pump station will be used to convey sewage from the Indian Lake southern shore to proposed gravity sewers located on the northern shore of Lake Stonycreek in Stonycreek Township. Sewage will be treated at the proposed Sewage Treatment Plant in the Borough of Shanksville. The key implementation activities/dates included submission of plan to PA D.E.P. October 2004, and begin design of facilities March 2005.

WHEREAS, Indian Lake Borough finds that the Facility Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake hereby adopts and submits to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the municipality, the above referenced Facility Plan. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, as amended).
