**RESOLUTION OF BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE  
FOR THE INTENTION TO ADOPT AN ORDINANCE  
FOR THE CREATION OF A GENERAL AUTHORITY**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, INTENDING TO ADOPT AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CREATION OF A GENERAL AUTHORITY UNDER THE MUNICIPALITY AUTHORITIES ACT.

**WHEREAS**, the BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE ("Borough"), Somerset County, Pennsylvania, is a municipality organized and governed by the Pennsylvania Borough Code, as amended, 53 P.S. § 45101, et. seq (the "Code"); and,

**WHEREAS**, the Municipalities Authorities Act, as amended, 53 Pa.C.S.A. § 5601, et seq grants municipalities the right to organize an authority to benefit the people of the Commonwealth by, among other things, increasing their commerce, health, safety and prosperity.

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality Authorities Act, as amended, 53 Pa.C.S.A § 5601, et seq also states that in order to organize an authority the municipality must hold a public hearing. There shall be at least 30 days notice before the hearing of the municipality's intention to adopt an ordinance for the organization of the authority.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Indian Lake Borough Council as follows:

SECTION 1. Indian Lake Borough Council intends to adopt an ordinance to organize a general authority under the Municipality Authorities Act, as amended 53 Pa.C.S.A. § 5601, et seq. at a public hearing to be held on July 25, 2007 at 6:30 o'clock p.m., prevailing time.

SECTION 2. Indian Lake Borough Council will advertise said hearing in the Somerset County Daily American and the Somerset County Legal Journal.

SECTION 3. The purpose of such public hearing is to receive comments from the public and answer questions concerning same with regards to the organization of the Indian Lake General Authority.

SECTION 4. The Borough may adopt amendments to this resolution which are necessary to implement the provisions and purposes of the Act. A copy of this resolution shall be conspicuously posted at the Borough's offices.
